



Declaration of Independence of the Russian Republic

Adopted on the Twenty-third day of December two thousand sixteen

We, the legal representatives acting on behalf of the Russian indigenous people, not having the Russian statehood for a long time, showing the will of the Russian indigenous people to self-determination, who, in 2003, established the Russian Republic, which is the legal successor of the Russian Republic (1917 - 1918) and the Russian Soviet Federative Socialist Republic (1918 - 1991) in order to take an independent and equal place among the nations of the world to which the Russian indigenous people have the right, expressing deep respect for humanity, we explain the reasons that propelled this decision of ours:

based on the obvious truth that the indigenous people have inalienable rights, among which there is a right to self-determination, a right to life, and a right to freedom;

for the implementation of these rights, indigenous people elect a government, which derives their legitimate powers from the consent of those being governed, and if any form of government becomes destructive for these objectives, the indigenous people have the right to abolish it and to elect a new government, based on the principles and forms of organization of power, which, as it seems to the people are best to implement security, stability and prosperity;

Russian indigenous people, showing their patience to political control for a long time, led slavish existence and only the need for survival as a nation is forcing them to change the previous system, with respect to both its existence and its external management;

a history of operating external control systems - the Russian Empire, the R. S. F. S. R. and the current - the Russian Federation - is a collection of innumerable injustices and violence, the immediate purpose of which is the destruction of the Russian indigenous people.

To confirm the above, we submit the following facts to the impersonal court of all Mankind:

plunder of national wealth and natural resources of the Russian indigenous people through a criminal privatization of industry and agriculture;

genocide against the Russian indigenous people and other indigenous peoples of the Russian Republic, being conducted by the existing Russian Federation;

arrangement and incentivation of migration into the territory of the Russian Republic of foreigners from Caucasian, Asian and other countries for the criminal capture of the economy, the assimilation of population and the seizure of the Russian cities, followed by the replacement of the Russian indigenous people and other indigenous peoples of the Russian Republic with foreigners;

adopting alienation policy of the areas of traditionally inhabited by the indigenous people of Russia and transfer it to private ownership by foreign entities.

Based on the foregoing, we, the legitimate representatives of the Russian indigenous people, having gathered on this memorable day, proclaim the independence of the Russian Republic in the territories of

Altai, Krasnodar, Krasnoyarsk, Primorsk, Stavropol, and Khabarovsk Krai;

Amur, Arkhangelsk, Astrakhan, Belgorod, Bryansk, Vladimir, Volgograd, Vologda, Voronezh, Ivanovo, Irkutsk, Kaliningrad, Kaluga, Kamchatka, Kemerovo, Kirov, Kostroma, Kurgan, Kursk, Leningrad, Lipetsk, Magadan, Moscow, Murmansk, Nizhny Novgorod, Novgorod, Novosibirsk, Omsk, Orenburg, Orel, Penza, Perm, Pskov, Rostov, Ryazan, Samara, Saratov and Sakhalin, Sverdlovsk, Smolensk, Tambov, Tver, Tomsk, Tula, Tyumen, Ulyanovsk, Chelyabinsk, Chita, Yaroslavl Oblast and those that do not affect other national entities, located within the boundaries of the former R. S. F. S. R.,

solemnly

proclaim that all the concluded and being concluded international treaties, constitutional laws, federal laws, laws and regulations on behalf of the Russian Federation, affecting the interests of the Russian Republic, are null and void;

claim that everything, which is on the territory of the Russian Republic, is its property and equally belongs to the indigenous peoples of the Russian Republic;

declare that all areas with bodies of water, natural resources, including the continental shelf of the northern sea areas and the territory of the Kuril chain, included in the Russian Republic, handed over by the Russian Federation to foreign States shall be deemed captured by these states and shall be returned to the Russian Republic;

claim that the Russian Republic is authorized to conclude international agreements, join unions, trade, do all other acts and all that, to which an independent state has a right.

and we state:

that the Russian indigenous people is a free and independent nation, which gained the Russian statehood in the face of the Russian Republic;

the Russian indigenous people are exempt from any dependence and responsibilities with respect to the Russian Federation acting on the territory of the Russian Republic.

With the firm belief, we swear to each other to maintain this Declaration with our life, our fortune and our unblemished Honor

and endorse all the written above by our signatures.
